**Text.** *Calculus (Early Transcendentals)*, by Edwards and Penney, 6th edition. We will cover most of chapters 11, 12, 13, 14.

**Pre-requisites.** Math 230 with a grade of A, or a score of 5 on the AP Calculus BC exam.

**Homework.** Every Thursday starting Sept. 1 a homework assignment will be due. Each assignment will have a practice component (problems to work but not turn in), and a turn-in component. Exam questions are sometimes based on the practice problems, so you should make every effort to complete them.

**Exams.** Three “midterm” exams will be given during the semester (dates to be announced). They will have the same type and difficulty of problems as found in a regular section of Math 243. **Make-up exams will not be given.**

**Grades.** The course grade will be determined by homework (10%), midterm exams (20% each), and the final exam (30%). All grades will be numerical (e.g. 0–100). For final course grades, 90% guarantees you an A-, 80% guarantees you a B-, etc.
