Please Note. The sign $+$ has a specific meaning in mathematics. Do not use it to mean 'and'.

Do not divide by anything that is not a nonzero real number, or can be evaluated as a nonzero real number (such as a polynomial or a determinant.) Dividing by a vector or matrix is not accepted.
